Retired Financial V.P. Dies

Brother James M. Kenny, S.J., who recently retired as Fordham Financial Vice President and Treasurer died at New York Hospital Thanksgiving morning, November 28, President Joseph A. O'Hare, S.J. announced. Services were held on December 2 in the University Church on the Rose Hill campus.

Awarded the University's Insignis Medal in 1966 for his role in financing the development of the Lincoln Center campus, Brother Kenny first came to Fordham in 1946 as the Director of Purchasing. Brother Kenny received the Bene Merenti Award the same year as the Insignis Medal and, at the May 1985 Fordham commencement, had conferred on him an honorary Doctor of Laws degree.

Brother Kenny is survived by his two sisters, Sister Mary Catherine, R.J.M. and Sister Mary, R.J.M.
